It gives you a boost. You feel as if you can tackle other stuff in your life.

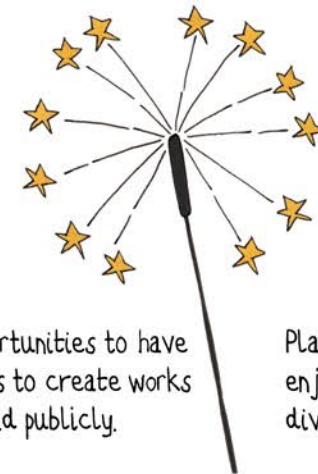


Playing With Fire is our long-term creative vision, co-produced by our participants and developed from a research project called 'Spark'.
